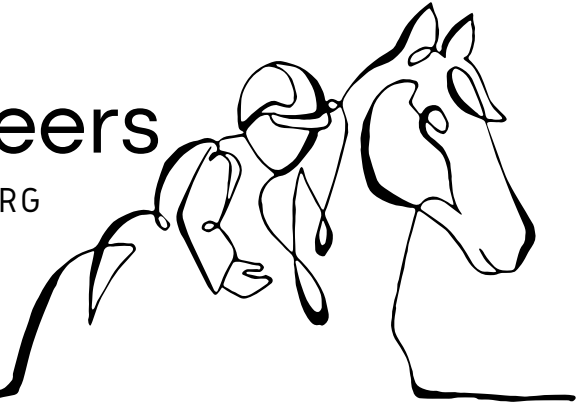




Jr. Volunteers

Overview

Jr. Volunteers will help by doing various jobs around the facilities to help keep, our horses, students, and visitors feeling safe and happy in a clean and orderly environment.

Description

Jr. Volunteers will sign up to come at established times, accompanied by an adult and do various important jobs. Some of these jobs will include mucking, washing grooming tools, troughs, and buckets, cleaning tack, sweeping, dusting, raking and picking up sticks. Some times when needed a volunteer may be asked to assist in the arena or groom horses. We may add special work days for bigger projects when lessons are not in session.

Expectations

- Wear clothing that is appropriate and can get dirty, and close toed shoes.
- Only come at designated times unless approved otherwise.
- Upon arrival, check the Jr. Volunteer board for list of jobs that need to be done.
- Please be respectful and quiet around the horses and our students. No running or yelling as it might spook the horses or distract students.
- Don't hesitate to ask for help from an adult (parent or other adult volunteer) if you don't know how to do something, but be mindful not to interrupt a lesson.
- Always return things to the correct location.
